- 3** Write your essay(s), attach your reference letter(s), and include extra-curricular activities, such as: **clubs, sports, academic awards, and employment or volunteer experience.**
- 4** The application saves as you go. **Be sure to submit when you're done.**

Be automatically considered for merit-based scholarships by submitting your application materials and being tentatively admitted (*must have 7th semester or 10th trimester transcript on file*) by the **March 1 Priority Deadline**.² Additional scholarships are available through our Scholarship Portal and check out our website for outside scholarship opportunities.

The general scholarship application is separate from the admission application. Incomplete and late applications will not be considered. ACT is composite score. SAT score is a combination of evidence-based reading and writing and math. To be considered based on ACT/SAT scores, students must have at least a 2.5 minimum GPA.

Full-time consists of 12-19 credits.
