‡All Idaho nursing schools operate under the Idaho Statewide Nursing Articulation Agreement, which is designed to facilitate the progression of nurses from one educational level to the next. This agreement provides for escrow credits, which are a means for nurses to be granted academic credits for previous nursing knowledge. There is a fee of \$20.00 per escrow credit to have these credits appear on the student's transcript. CSI students taking only the minimum credits required for their ASN may need up to 25 escrow credits.
