- The advising guide is based on completion of an Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer degree (AAOT) in Justice Studies at Treasure Valley Community College with additions made to meet lower division requirements
- Courses used to fulfill specific general education core requirements cannot be double-counted to fulfill LC State program requirements
- TVCC classes are in quarter credits. LC State classes are semester
- 32 residency (LC State) credits required for graduation
- 36 credits must be upper division

At TVCC a minimum grade of "C-" is required for Gen Ed courses and a minimum 2.0 GPA is required to qualify for Associate's Degree.
