4. The remaining 59-63 credits taken from LC State for the bachelor's degree are all available online. Professional Internships require a face-to-face placement in a school at a location mutually acceptable to the student and LC State.

5. College of Eastern Idaho a minimum grade of C is required for Gen Ed courses and a minimum 2.0 GPA is required for an Associate's Degree. Admission to LC State's Teacher Education Program requires a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or higher.
