- **Bookstore Discount:** LC State faculty and staff and their immediate relatives are eligible to receive discounts from Textbook Brokers, the college’s new bookstore/apparel partner. The discounts are available online <https://lcstatebookstore.com/> or in store. To receive the discount online use code STAFF20 when checking out under the faculty or staff member’s name and for in-person, please provide your LC ID card.
 - 10% discount on any new textbooks
 - 15% discount on any used textbooks
 - 20% discount on all non-course materials merchandise items sold in store or online
 - All applicable discounts will be granted on all sales of \$1 or more and cannot be combined with other sales, discounts, or store promotions unless otherwise specified. Discounts are not applicable for rental textbooks.
- **Can You Do? (CYD):** This edition of CYD is very simple and the purpose is to make sure (1) You know how to access the new Intranet via Teams and (2) You feel comfortable using it. The hope is that all of campus will become active users of the Intranet to share information, ask questions, congratulate each other on accomplishments and milestones, and even to share funny (albeit professional 😊) memes. - **HR Updates:**
 - **Employee Compliance Training:** All benefit-eligible faculty and staff received a personalized email from [VectorSolutions](#) containing the compliance tutorials they must

complete by Oct. 31. Please check your Clutter or Junk email if you did not receive this email in your inbox. As a reminder, usernames consist of your first initial, middle initial, and last name (Ex: vjswift). You will not be required to enter a password. If you have questions, please contact Human Resource Services at 208-792-2269.

- **LCMail:** LCMail will prompt users to enroll in Two-Step Verification (also known as Multi Factor Authentication). This policy will be enforced on Sept. 27 which means that users will be asked to enter a one-time password when signing in. This one-time password will be sent to either your recovery email or phone that was configured during enrollment. After Sept. 27, anyone who has not enrolled will be locked out of their account and will require a bypass code from the Help Desk. Two-Step Verification helps to protect the account by providing stronger security.
- **Parking Permits:** 2023-2024 parking permits are available and ready for [purchase online](#). Please allow up to 48 hours after your purchase to pick up your permit at the Public Safety office, MLH 110, anytime between 7:30 a.m.-4 p.m., Monday-Friday. Ticketing will begin Monday, Aug. 28.
 - Annual permit: \$75
 - Semester permit: \$50
 - 30-day pass: \$25
- **Pep Band Meeting:** A meeting will take place in the Music Building on Aug. 28 from 2-3 p.m. for students who are interested in joining the Pep Band. It will cover the dates of rehearsals and performances, which music will be played, and other important information. - **Sodexo Marketplace:**
 - **All You Care to Eat:** This fall, the SUB Marketplace will be switching to an "All You Care to Eat" at lunch (as done for breakfast and dinner). A la carte options will no longer be available. Customers can either use a meal swipe or pay the door price. Some a la carte options will be available in Jitterz. Also, to-go containers will no longer be available in the Marketplace. **As part of our sustainability initiative**, customers wanting to take their food to go can purchase a green to-go container for a one-time fee of \$5. They can then exchange that container for a clean, empty one the next time they come in to eat.
 - **Jackfruit:** For people who enjoy a more plant-based meal option, Sodexo is now offering Jackfruit as a part of its menu rotation. Jackfruit comes from tropical and subtropical areas around the world, including Malaysia, Africa and Thailand. Young jackfruit has a neutral flavor, and a texture similar to that of shredded pork. This makes it an ideal plant based alternative for dishes such as BBQ chicken or pork, taco meat, and many others. It'll be on the menu for dinner, as part of a Cumin Jackfruit Taco Salad on Aug. 24, but that won't be the last time you see it. Come by the Marketplace and give it a try and let them know what you think.
