## Similarity Reports and AI Detection

Last month, we indicated Turnitin purchased Unicheck and is now the tool in LC Canvas for plagiarism detection for assignments. We also want faculty to know that Turnitin has AI Writing Detection. However, unlike the Similarity Report that highlights potential plagiarism issues for students, the AI detection report is **only visible to instructors**. You'll find this report on the right side of the Similarity Report under AI.

## Technical Issues with Peer Reviews in Canvas



Currently there is a technical issue students are encountering when completing Peer Reviews in Canvas. eLearning is in contact with Canvas support to resolve the issue, but at this time no timeline for the fix has been indicated. If you are using Peer Reviews in your course, you will need to instruct students on how to access them.

Students CANNOT access peer review from Modules. Canvas added a feature where the student sees a link to their assigned peer review within the module under the peer review assignment. However, those links are NOT working correctly. Using these links will result in students not seeing a review to complete or seeing the wrong student's paper to review.

Instead, students need to open the assignment and access their peer reviews from the right-hand sidebar. This will indicate the correct Peer Reviews they need to complete.
