



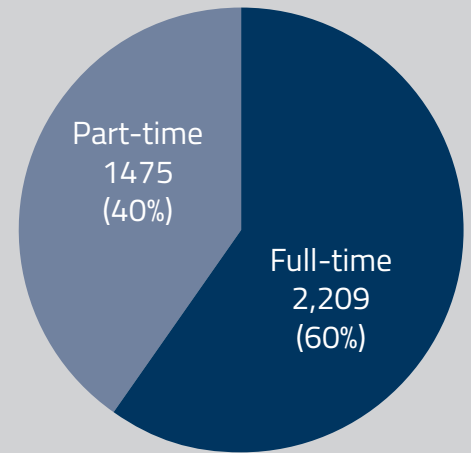
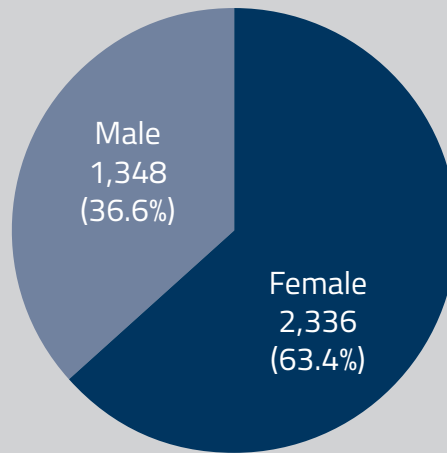
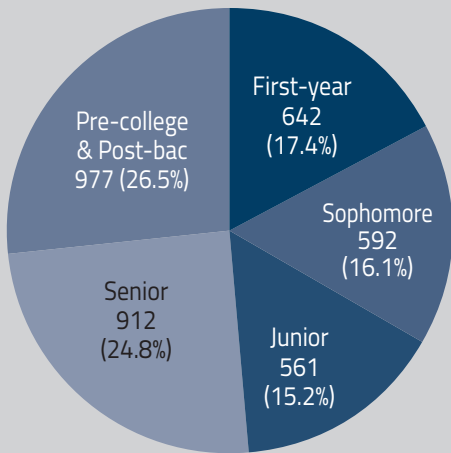
# LEWIS-CLARK STATE COLLEGE

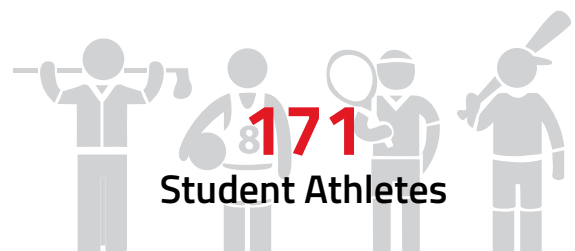

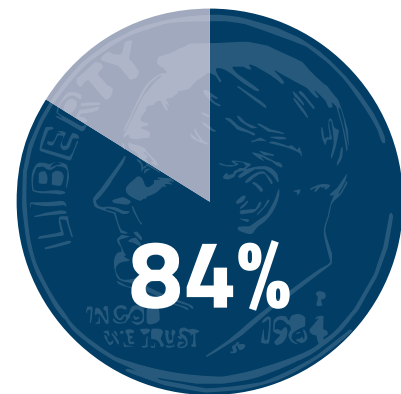

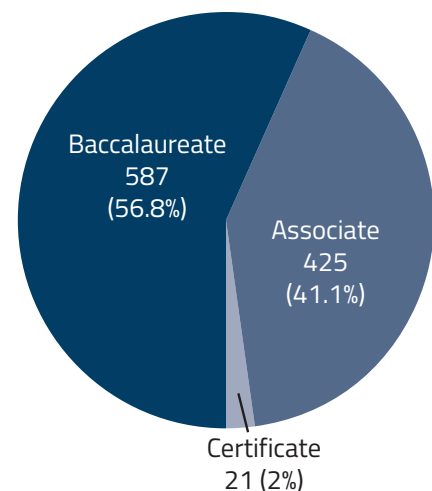
## Student to Faculty Ratio



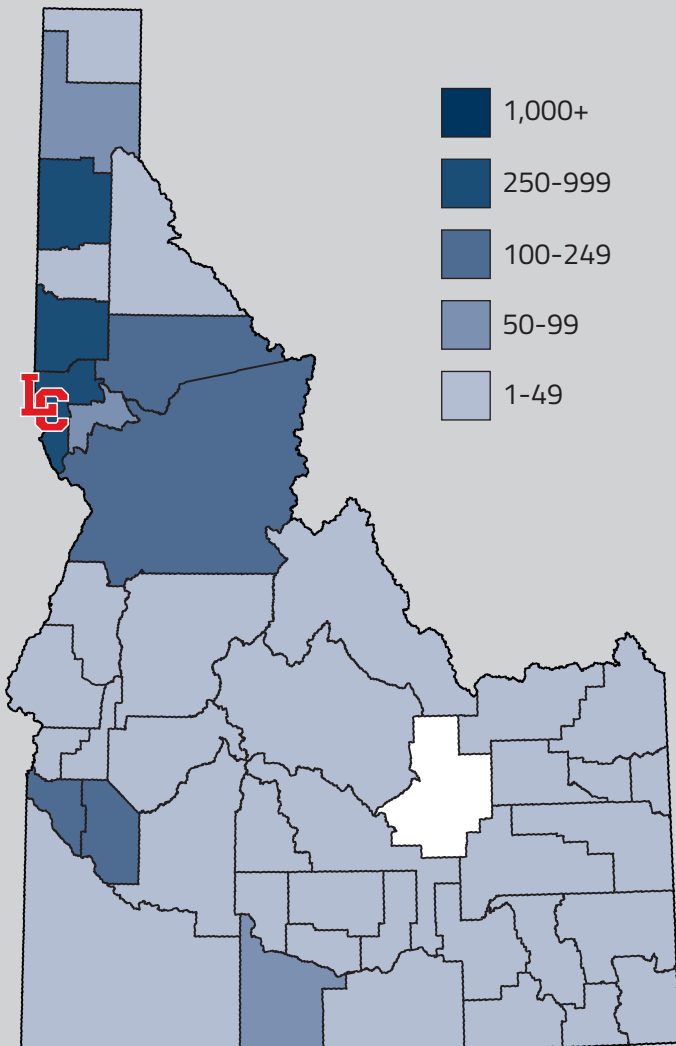
## Students Receiving Financial Aid
