<p><i>*Not a prerequisite for nursing at LC State, but is required for graduation. This course may also be taken online after admittance to the BSN, during a summer, before graduation.</i></p> <p>This plan outlines the specific classes at WSU that will transfer to Lewis-Clark State. If you wish to qualify for both WSU and LC State nursing programs, there are specific classes that are needed only for the WSU College of Nursing. In addition, there are two courses needed by the LC nursing program that are not required for the WSU program.</p> <p>Students must have a minimum Sci/Stat GPA of 2.75 at the time of application; this includes the most recent attempt in Chem 102, Physiology, Anatomy, Microbiology and Statistics. No more than 2 of these courses may be in-progress at the time of application. All prerequisite courses must be passed with a grade of "C" or better.</p> <p>LCSC's BSN applications are accepted every fall and spring via www.NursingCAS.org.
