# 1. Updates

### President's Update

- Governor's State of State Address
  - Directed SBOE to hire Chief Educational Officer (\$200k salary + benefits)
  - \$500k for consultant to study ways to integrate & combine services across higher education institutions in Idaho
  - Create a statewide digital campus
  - 3% CEC increase in permanent state employee salaries (1.5% will be funded by LCSC tuition)
  - Overall increase for higher education, no increase for LCSC
  - 15.31% increase in funding for community colleges
  - \$5.0 million for college & career advising
  - \$6.5 million to expand literacy intervention efforts
  - \$10.0 million in school technology bringing total annual investment to \$36 million
  - General Education area no line items approved
  - Pay scale as a whole moves up 3%
  - \$5 million for the Opportunity Scholarships
  - CTE did well
  - Decrease in cost of health insurance (2 month benefit "holiday")
  - IRON initiative was not funded
