Topic: Syllabi for New Courses

As divisions are putting together new courses and creating the syllabus to accompany it, the following items need to be included:

<u>Course (as defined by NWCCU)</u>: A purposeful structured sequence of teaching and learning leading to achievement of student learning outcomes related to one or more academic topics. It is commonly designated by a title, number, credits, and expected learning outcomes.

- 1. Learning outcomes
- 2. Any prerequisites listed on the syllabus match the proposal and course description.
- 3. Basis for grade determination
 - a. Assessments listing
 - b. Assignments listing
 - c. grade scale used for course
- 4. Topical outline

Some of these items may be listed multiple times or combined. Verification is they are included.
