

24 Month STEM OPT Extension Eligibility Checklist

You must meet the following requirements to qualify for an OPT STEM Extension:

- 1. Have obtained a bachelor degree in an eligible STEM field
- 2. F-1 students must pursue their STEM OPT extension through an employer that is enrolled in USCIS's <u>E-verify employment eligibility program</u>. Consult with your HR representative to ensure your employer meets this standard.
- Work a minimum of 20 hours per week per employer. Volunteer hours or hours total 20+ through multiple part-time positions are <u>not</u> allowed for the OPT STEM Extension.
- 4. Work with employer that provides student with formal training and learning objectives as required by Form I-983 Training Plan for STEM OPT Students (must be submitted).
- 5. Must be in valid F-1 visa status, and abiding by all conditions of status
- 6. Must be within 90 days of OPT end date.
