# Lewis Clark State College Cadaver Laboratory Regulations

## 1. Respect

Willed Body Program Donors deserve respect for their unselfish donation. This includes...

- a. **NO** Photography
- b. Exposure should be limited to only the anatomy being studied
- c. Only students and faculty studying anatomy are allowed in the Laboratory. (Authorized Visitors Only)

#### 2. General Rules

- a. **NO** eating or drinking in the Laboratory.
- b. Proper cadaver care and maintenance required
- c. Laboratory is maintained in a clean and orderly manner.
- d. A faculty member or authorized Teaching Assistant must be present.
- e. Only faculty or BIO 420: Human Dissection students are allowed to manipulate cadavers.

#### 3. Dress Code

Professional Laboratory dress code required by Teaching Assistants

- a. Laboratory coats are required
- b. Name badge is required
- c. Exam gloves are required

### 4. Cadaver Care:

- a. NEVER allow cadaver to dry out anywhere.
- b. Keep cadaver draped with wet covering sheet except the area being studied.
- c. Apply wetting agent generously every 20 minutes to exposed areas.
- d. Report any suspected deterioration to your lab instructor.
- e. Never use paper towels directly on the cadaver.
- f. Place dissected tissue debris in the proper containers.
