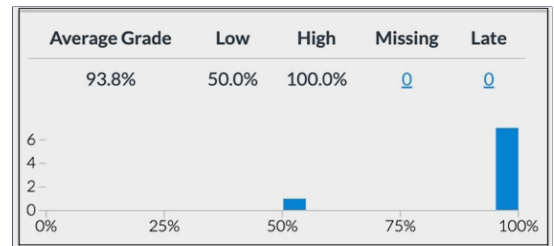

New Analytics. Valuable Information.

New Analytics is a powerful tool in courses that allows instructors to see performance data for assignments, quizzes, and discussions; class averages for weekly online activity (views and participations); and individual student page views and participations, date of last access, and current grade.

Access this tool to generate a list of missing, late, or excused assignments and export course activity reports for individual students. You can also see at-a-glance performance data for all graded items in your course:

Quiz Response Quandaries? View Log for Answers!

You can view quiz logs to view the status of your student quizzes. This feature is also designed to help you investigate problems that a student may have in the quiz. The quiz starts the log when students begin the quiz, so some logs may show that the quiz is in progress.

In the log, you can view the time and date a student began the assessment and completed the assessment. You can also view each event a student completed while taking the assessment and the time that event was completed.
