## Close Contact Protocols Fall 2022

Close Contact\* to a case of COVID-19

Is the person vaccinated?\*\*

Yes

- Person must wear a mask when in public for 10 days OR quarantine for 5 days from the contact.
- Person is encouraged to test for COVID-19 no sooner than Day 5 after the contact.
- Person should continue to monitor themselves for symptoms.
- \*Close contact is defined as being within 6 feet of someone for more than 15 minutes over a 24-hour period without a face covering.

- Person must quarantine for 5 days from the contact.
- If the person in quarantine is symptom free, a shortened quarantine is possible after 5 days by testing no sooner than Day 5 and producing a negative test result. If the test result is negative, the person must continue to wear a mask in public until Day 10.

\*Close contact is defined as being within 6 feet of someone for more than 15 minutes over a 24-hour period without a face covering.

\*\*Vaccinated means someone who has received all recommended vaccine doses including boosters and additional primary shots for those who are immunocompromised.

No

People who have been positive with COVID-19 within 90 days prior to the close contact will follow the protocols of those who are vaccinated.
