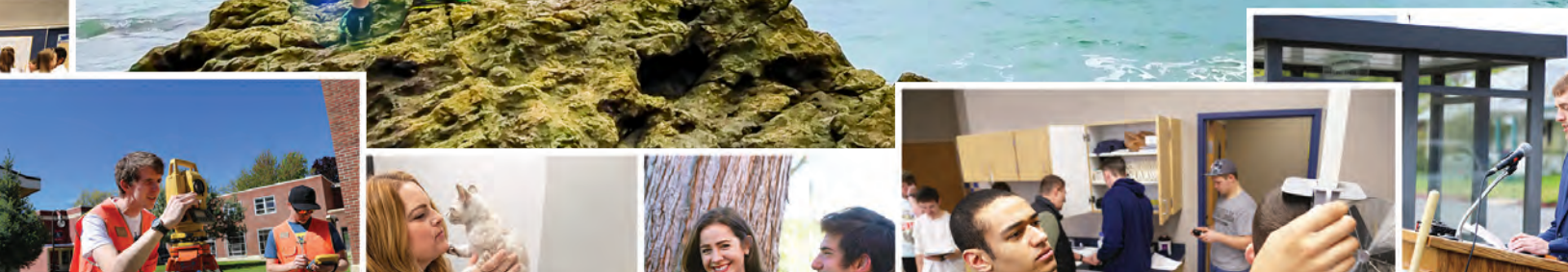

- 3** Write your essay(s), attach your reference letter(s), and include extra-curricular activities. Include extra-curricular activities such as **clubs, sports, academic awards, and employment or volunteer experience.**
- 4** The application saves as you go. **Be sure to submit when you're done.**

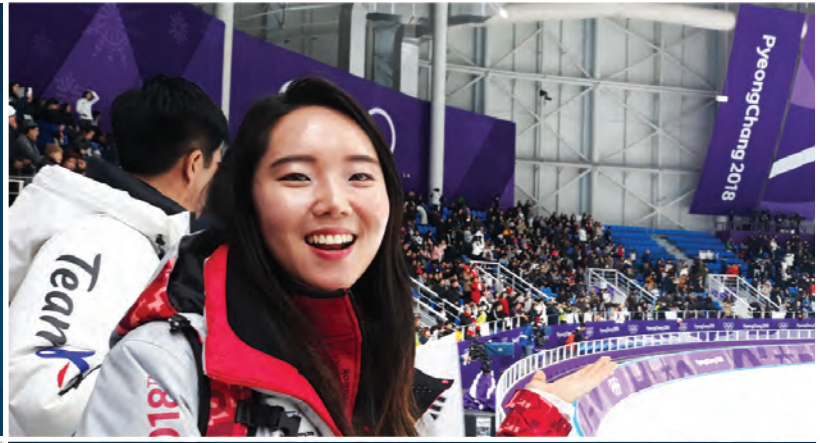
